## White

- 1. Alasia Piemonte Cortese, Italy** | Carafe £13.50 Glass £5.25 Bottle £16.95  
Fresh green apple aromas with notes of grapefruit, lime and honeysuckle. The palate is lightly honeyed, yet fresh and crisp with citrus flavours and a mineral note on the finish.
- 2. Diez Siglos Verdejo, Rueda, Spain** | Carafe £15.50 Glass £5.75 Bottle £18.50  
Complex aromas of fresh grass, nettle and passion fruit, tangerine oil and citrus. A rounded and complex palate, delicately mirroring the nose, with savoury hints and bitter marmalade to finish.
- 3. Domaine Uby Colombard Ugni Blanc, Gascony, France** | Carafe £16.50 Glass £6.25 Bottle £21  
Fabulous easy drinking wine, great lunch time wine as light. Imagine if Sauvignon Blanc grew up in Hawaii. Beautiful fresh tropical fruits with hints of fresh grapefruit and peach.
- 4. The Cloud Factory Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand** | Bottle £22.00  
Perfumed with nettle and ample ripe tropical fruits which are evident on the palate too along with limey flavours and a rich minerality – classic Marlborough Sauvignon.

## Rose

- 5. Castillo del Moro Rosé, Spain** | Carafe £13.50 Glass £5.25 Bottle £16.95  
This Rosado is crammed full of juicy wild strawberry, raspberry & cranberry fruit. Rich in colour, the wine is crisp and well balanced with a long finish of strawberries and cream.

## Red

- 6. Borsao Garnacha, Spain** | Carafe £13.50 Glass £5.25 Bottle £16.95  
Juicy bramble and cherry fruit and fresh redcurrants dominate this generous, easy drinking wine. Supple tannins are balanced by good acidity and blackberry notes, with a hint of liquorice and black pepper.
- 7. Sobreiro de Pegões 'Premium', Castelao Aragonez/Cabernet Sauvignon Setubal, Portugal** | Carafe £16.50 Glass £5.75 Bottle £18.50  
Cracking value for money, rich black baked fruits and spice, with soft yet rich mouthfeel.
- 8. Viu Manent Merlot, Colchagua, Chile** | Carafe £16.95 Glass £5.95 Bottle £20.00  
Blackberry, cherry and plums with sweet cassis and chocolate notes, combined with fresh acidity and soft tannins leading to a long, balanced finish.
- 9. Nieto Malbec, Argentina** | Bottle £22.00  
Full bodied with a great concentration of vanilla, mocha, blackberries, sweet spices and clove. The palate is rich and warming with vanilla, more black fruit, plums and cherries, as well as leathery notes. The wine is vibrant and well structured, with powdery, fragrant tannins.

## Sparkling

- 10. Prosecco Casa Defra, Italy** | Bottle £17.95  
Bright straw yellow in colour, with a delicate and fine bouquet. A beautifully fruity frizzante!
